

The wines undergo temperature-controlled fermentation and aging in stainless steel, followed by further aging in both steel and large French oak casks for a duration of 5–7 years in casks ranging from 28 to 42HL in size.

Matteo's winemaking philosophy is straightforward: he embraces artisanal practices, exclusively utilizing estate-grown fruit. With a commitment to environmentally friendly vineyard management, certified through integrated agriculture practices, he opts for manual harvesting in boxes. His ultimate goal is to craft wines that are impeccably balanced and elegantly expressive.
